2. **Length:** Full papers should be between 1,000 and 2,500 words, including references and footnotes.
3. **Formatting:** Use MLA style guidelines with double-spaced text, one-inch margins, and 12-point Times New Roman font.
4. **Language:** Papers can be written in English, Hindi, or Marathi.
5. **Originality:** Submissions must be original and not published elsewhere. Proper citations are required to avoid plagiarism.

6. Structure: Papers should have a clear structure, including an introduction, main body, and conclusion.
7. References: Include all references at the end of the paper, formatted as per MLA guidelines.
8. Biographical Note: Provide a short biographical note with your institutional affiliation, address, and contact number.
9. Submission: Submit your paper as a Word document to the designated email address by the stated deadline.
10. Review Process: All submissions will undergo a peer-review process, and feedback will be provided within 6-8 days of submission.
